A Concurrent Enrollment Program in Conjunction with Red Rocks Community College October 11, 2012

Last academic year, 2011-12, Ascent/Concurrent Enrollment enabled:

18 Students to receive college credit in math: 9 in MAT 120 (Discrete Math)

9 in MAT 166 (Pre-Calculus)

11 Students to receive college credit in physics: 2 in ENV 101 (AP Enviro. Science)

3 in PHY 111 (AP Physics Algebra-Based) 4 in PHY 112 (AP Physics Algebra-Based) 2 in PHY 211 (AP Physics Calc.-Based)

39 Students to receive college credit in English: 33 in ENG 121 (English Honors 11)

6 in ENG 122 (English Honors 12)

The total for students who received college credit through Ascent/Concurrent enrollment for Academic Year 2011-12, is 68 students received college credit.

There are 33 students whose names have been submitted to the State for 5th Year Ascent participation at RRCC (Academic Year 2013-14).

The total number of students positively impacted by the Ascent Program in the last two years, at Arvada High School is: 101.

The Ascent Program impacts approximately 10.6% of the entire population of Arvada High School.
